Please send your abstract(s) until per Email until October 1, 2009 ([martin.kuecke@jki.bund.de](mailto:martin.kuecke@jki.bund.de)). Your abstract will be published in a book of abstracts which will be handed at the begin to all participants of the symposium.

Speaker are requested to send a long version of their contribution for publication in the symposiums proceedings (Julius Kühn-Archives). Guidelines for the long version can be found soon on the website of the JKI (under Aktuelles and Veranstaltungskalender).

The long version should be submitted electronically by December 31, 2009.
